Key Differences Between Cub Pack and Scout Troop

	Pack	Troop
Team Unit	Dens	Patrols
Leadership	Adults Lead Den & Pack	Scouts Lead Patrol & Troop
Adult Leaders are called:	Den Leaders	Assistant Scoutmasters (ASMs)
Activities	Den Leader(s) head Den meetings and are responsible for planning activities.	Patrol Leaders (Scouts) are responsible for selecting and planning the activities that a troop participates in.
Skills	Learn skills through adult-led classes	Learn skills by earning merit badges.
Meeting Times	Pack: Monthly Den: twice a month	Troop: Weekly on Tues Campouts: Once a month
Meetings	Den meets on their own twice a month.	The troop and all of its patrols meet together each week during Tuesday troop meetings.
Role of Adult Leaders	Define Program Lead & Drive Program Safety	Safety Coach/Guide "Don't do for the scout what the scout can do for themselves". Sign-off requirements
Role of Parents	Actively Help complete requirements	Encourage Engage Coach
Advancement	Defined by age & grade	Scout sets their own pace. Earns advancement by completing requirements and earning merit badges..
Requirements	Parents sign-off	Uniformed Adult Leaders sign-off
